A BILL

To amend chapter 8 of title 5, United States Code, to require Federal agencies to submit to the Comptroller General of the United States a report on rules that are revoked, suspended, replaced, amended, or otherwise made ineffective.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “GAO Database Mod-
5 ernization Act of 2024”.

1 **SEC. 2. RULES NO LONGER IN EFFECT.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 801(a)(1) of title 5,
3 United States Code, is amended by adding at the end the
4 following:

5 “(D) For any rule submitted under subparagraph
6 (A), if the Federal agency promulgating the rule, in whole
7 or in part, revokes, suspends, replaces, amends, or other-
8 wise makes the rule ineffective, or the rule is made ineffec-
9 tive for any other reason, the Federal agency shall submit
10 to the Comptroller General a report containing—

11 (i) the title of the rule;

12 (ii) the Federal Register citation for the rule,
13 if any;

14 (iii) the date on which rule was submitted to
15 the Comptroller General; and

16 (iv) a description of the provisions of the rule
17 that are being revoked, suspended, replaced, amend-
18 ed, or otherwise made ineffective.”.

19 (b) SUNSET.—Effective on the date that is 6 years
20 after the date of enactment of this Act, section 801(a)(1)
21 of title 5, United States Code, is amended by striking sub-
22 paragraph (D), as added by subsection (a).

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
