A BILL

To amend the Richard B. Russell National School Lunch Act to allow schools that participate in the school lunch program under such Act to serve whole milk.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Whole Milk for
5 Healthy Kids Act of 2019”.

1 **SEC. 2. WHOLE MILK PERMISSIBLE.**

2 Section 9(a)(2)(A) of the Richard B. Russell National
3 School Lunch Act (42 U.S.C. 1758(a)(2)(A)) is amend-
4 ed—

5 (1) in clause (i), by striking “. Such milk shall
6 be consistent with the most recent Dietary Guide-
7 lines for Americans published under section 301 of
8 the National Nutrition Monitoring and Related Re-
9 search Act of 1990 (7 U.S.C. 5341)”; and

10 (2) in clause (ii), by inserting “, flavored and
11 unflavored whole milk,” after “unflavored fluid
12 milk”.
