Mrs. CHAVEZ-DEREMER introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Natural Resources

A BILL

To amend the Oregon Resource Conservation Act of 1996 to reauthorize the Deschutes River Conservancy Working Group, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Deschutes River Con-
5 servancy Act of 2024”.

6 **SEC. 2. REAUTHORIZATION OF DESCHUTES RIVER CONSER-**
7 **VANCY ACT OF 2024.**

8 (a) DEFINITION OF WORKING GROUP.—Section
9 301(a) of the Oregon Resource Conservation Act of 1996
10 (Public Law 104–208; 110 Stat. 3009–534; 122 Stat.

1 836) is amended by striking paragraph (1) and inserting
2 the following:

3 “(1) WORKING GROUP.—The term ‘Working
4 Group’ means the Deschutes River Conservancy
5 Working Group composed of a board of directors of
6 not fewer than 10, but not more than 15, members
7 nominated by the group represented by the member,
8 of whom—

9 “(A) 2 members shall be of the environ-
10 mental community in the Deschutes River
11 Basin;

12 “(B) 2 members shall be representatives of
13 the irrigated agriculture community in the
14 Deschutes River Basin;

15 “(C) 2 members shall be representatives of
16 the Confederated tribes of the Warm Springs
17 Reservation of Oregon;

18 “(D) 1 member shall be a representative of
19 the hydroelectric production community in the
20 Deschutes River Basin;

21 “(E) 1 member shall be a representative of
22 1 of the Federal agencies with authority and re-
23 sponsibility in the Deschutes River Basin;

24 “(F) 1 member shall be a representative of
25 an agency of the State of Oregon with authority

1 and responsibility in the Deschutes River Basin,
2 such as—

3 “(i) the Oregon Department of Fish
4 and Wildlife; or

5 “(ii) the Oregon Water Resources De-
6 partment; and

7 “(G) 1 member shall be a representative of
8 a unit of local government in the Deschutes
9 River Basin.”.

10 (b) REAUTHORIZATION; ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS.—
11 Section 301 of the Oregon Resource Conservation Act of
12 1996 (Public Law 104–208; 110 Stat. 3009–534; 122
13 Stat. 836) is amended—

14 (1) in subsection (b)—

15 (A) in paragraph (3), by striking “2016”
16 and inserting “2034”; and

17 (B) in paragraph (6), by striking “5 per-
18 cent” and inserting “10 percent”; and

19 (2) in subsection (h), by striking “2016” and
20 inserting “2034”.
