A BILL

To direct the Secretary of the Army to submit to Congress a report in the event that the assessment of the Army force structure using the process known as “Total Army Analysis” does not include certain missions.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 (a) SHORT TITLE.—This Act may be cited as the
5 “Total Army Analysis Explosive Ordnance Disposal Do-
6 mestic Response Act of 2024”.

1 **SEC. 2. REPORT ON EXCLUSION OF CERTAIN MISSIONS IN**
2 **TOTAL ARMY ANALYSIS.**

3 (a) **REPORTING REQUIREMENT.**—If the Army con-
4 ducts an assessment of the Army force structure using the
5 process known as “Total Army Analysis” and such assess-
6 ment does not include each covered mission, the Secretary
7 of the Army shall submit to Congress a report that in-
8 cludes—

9 (1) an explanation for excluding the covered
10 mission in the assessment; and

11 (2) an analysis of the risk assumed to the
12 homeland by reason of excluding the covered mis-
13 sion.

14 (b) **COVERED MISSIONS.**—In this section, a covered
15 mission is any of the following:

16 (1) A Defense Support of Civil Authorities mis-
17 sion.

18 (2) A Very Important Personnel Protection
19 Support Activity mission.

20 (3) Any forces required for a mission referred
21 to in paragraph (1) or (2).

22 (c) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The requirement to submit
23 reports under subsection (a) shall take effect on the date
24 that is 180 days after the date of the enactment of this
25 Act.
