## A BILL

To prohibit any person convicted of an unlawful activity on or after October 7, 2023, on a college campus from being eligible for public service loan forgiveness.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Loan Forgiveness  
5 for Hamas Supporters Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION OF FUNDS.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Any person convicted of an unlaw-  
8 ful activity on or after October 7, 2023, on a campus of  
9 an institution of higher education shall be ineligible for

1 the public service loan forgiveness program under section  
2 455(m) of the Higher Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C.  
3 1087e(m)).

4 (b) DEFINITION.—In this section, the term “unlawful  
5 activity” means—

6 (1) an act of physical violence, as defined in  
7 section 5104 of title 40, United States Code; or

8 (2) any other violation of State or Federal law.
