A BILL

To reprogram funds appropriated to the United States Postal Service for the acquisition and support of zero-emission delivery vehicles to support the hiring and retention of rural employees.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Modifying Allocations
5 to Improve Local service Act” or the “MAIL Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. REPROGRAMMING OF ZERO-EMISSION VEHICLE**
2 **FUNDS FOR RURAL EMPLOYEES.**

3 The unobligated balance of funds made available
4 under section 70002 of Public Law 117–169 (commonly
5 referred to as the “Inflation Reduction Act”) shall be used
6 by the United States Postal Service to support hiring and
7 retaining employees of the United States Postal Service
8 whose primary duty stations are located in rural areas or
9 whose regular duty involves the collection and delivery of
10 mail on a rural route. The amounts reprogrammed under
11 this section shall remain available until expended.
