A BILL

To require consent for the Director of the United States Marshals Service to deputize certain law enforcement officers, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Keep Law Enforce-
5 ment Local Act of 2020”.

6 **SEC. 2. LIMITATIONS ON DEPUTATION AUTHORITY OF U.S.**

7 **MARSHALS SERVICE.**

8 (a) CONSENT REQUIRED.—The Director of the
9 United States Marshals Services shall not deputize local
10 law enforcement officers without the consent of the chief

1 executive of the unit of local government for which the
2 law enforcement officer is employed.

3 (b) WITHDRAWAL OF CONSENT.—The chief executive
4 of the unit of local government that provides consent pur-
5 suant to subsection (a), may withdraw such consent at any
6 time.
