# **A BILL**

To require the Transportation Security Administration conduct a study relating to the digitization of the law enforcement officer flying armed checkpoint data collection process, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Repair of the National  
5 Law Enforcement Telecommunications System Act of  
6 2024”.

7 **SEC. 2. STUDY RELATING TO DIGITIZATION OF THE LAW**  
8 **ENFORCEMENT OFFICER FLYING ARMED**  
9 **CHECKPOINT DATA COLLECTION PROCESS.**

10 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 180 days after the  
11 date of the enactment of this Act, the Administrator of  
12 the Transportation Security Administration, acting  
13 through the Director of the Federal Air Marshal Service,  
14 shall conduct a study on the digital data collection process  
15 for law enforcement officers who are flying armed.

16 (b) ELEMENTS.—The study required under sub-  
17 section (a) shall examine the following:

18 (1) Projected timelines for the digital data col-  
19 lection process referred to in such subsection.

20 (2) Estimated resources required to implement  
21 such process.

22 (c) BRIEFING; ACCESSIBILITY.—Upon completion of  
23 the study required under subsection (a), the Administrator  
24 of the Transportation Security Administration shall—

1           (1) provide to the Committee on Homeland Se-  
2           curity of the House of Representatives and the Com-  
3           mittee on Science, Commerce, and Transportation  
4           and the Committee on Homeland Security and Gov-  
5           ernmental Affairs of the Senate a briefing on the  
6           findings of such study; and

7           (2) make such study accessible in a digital for-  
8           mat suitable for use by the Administration.
