Mr. RUSH introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Education and Labor

A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Labor to fund youth workforce investment activities for certain local areas, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Jobs Now Youth Em-
5 ployment Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. YOUTH WORKFORCE INVESTMENT ACTIVITIES.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—From the amount made available
8 under subsection (e) for a fiscal year, the Secretary shall
9 make allotments to local areas pursuant to subsection (b)
10 for youth workforce investment activities under section

1 129 of the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (29
2 U.S.C. 3164).

3 (b) FORMULA.—The allotment to a local area under
4 subsection (a) shall be made on the basis of the relative
5 number of long-term unemployed individuals in each local
6 area, compared to the total number of long-term unem-
7 ployed individuals in all local areas.

8 (c) DATA COLLECTION.—In carrying out subsection
9 (a), the Secretary shall—

10 (1) beginning not later than 180 days after the
11 date of the enactment of this Act and annually
12 thereafter, the Secretary shall collect long-term un-
13 employment rates for local areas; and

14 (2) identify local areas that have long-term un-
15 employment rates above the national average for the
16 year for which such data is collected.

17 (d) DEFINITION.—In this section:

18 (1) LOCAL AREA.—The term “local area” has
19 the meaning given such term under section 3 of the
20 Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (29
21 U.S.C. 3102).

22 (2) LONG-TERM UNEMPLOYMENT.—The term
23 “long-term unemployment”, used with respect to a
24 local area, means the number of individuals in such

1 local area who have been unemployed for 15 weeks
2 or more.

3 (3) SECRETARY.—The term “Secretary” means
4 the Secretary of Labor.

5 (e) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There is
6 authorized to be appropriated to carry out the activities
7 described in subsection (a) \$10,000,000,000 for each year
8 in the 10-year period beginning on the date that is the
9 first fiscal year that commences following the existence of
10 data collected under subsection (c).

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
