A BILL

To expand the boundary of San Antonio Missions National Historical Park, to conduct a study of potential land acquisitions, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 *This Act may be cited as the “San Antonio Missions*
5 *National Historical Park Boundary Expansion Act of*
6 *2013”.*

7 **SEC. 2. BOUNDARY EXPANSION.**

8 *Section 201(a) of Public Law 95–629 (16 U.S.C.*
9 *410ee(a)) is amended—*

10 *(1) by striking “In order” and inserting “(1) In*
11 *order”;*

12 *(2) by striking “The park shall also” and insert-*
13 *ing the following:*

14 *“(2) The park shall also”;*

15 *(3) by striking “After advising the” and insert-*
16 *ing the following:*

17 *“(5) After advising the”.*

18 *(4) by inserting after paragraph (2) (as so des-*
19 *ignated by paragraph (2)) the following:*

20 *“(3) The boundary of the park is further modified to*
21 *include approximately 137 acres, as depicted on the map*
22 *titled ‘San Antonio Missions National Historical Park Pro-*
23 *posed Boundary Addition’, numbered 472/113,006A, and*
24 *dated June 2012. The map shall be on file and available*

1 for inspection in the appropriate offices of the National
2 Park Service, U.S. Department of the Interior.

3 “(4) The Secretary may not acquire by condemnation
4 any land or interest in land within the boundaries of the
5 park. The Secretary is authorized to acquire land and inter-
6 ests in land that are within the boundaries of the park pur-
7 suant to paragraph (3) by donation or exchange only (and
8 in the case of an exchange, no payment may be made by
9 the Secretary to any landowner). No private property or
10 non-Federal public property shall be included within the
11 boundaries of the park without the written consent of the
12 owner of such property. Nothing in this Act, the establish-
13 ment of the park, or the management plan of the park shall
14 be construed to create buffer zones outside of the park. That
15 an activity or use can be seen or heard from within the
16 park shall not preclude the conduct of that activity or use
17 outside the park.”.

Amend the title so as to read: “A bill to expand the boundary of the San Antonio Missions National Historical Park, and for other purposes.”.
