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## A BILL

To amend title 23, United States Code, to create a pilot program concerning drugged driving prevention, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Reinforcing Impaired  
5 Driving Education Act of 2021” or the “RIDE Act of  
6 2021”.

1 **SEC. 2. PILOT PROGRAM ON DRUGGED DRIVING PREVEN-**  
2 **TION.**

3 Section 403 of title 23, United States Code, is  
4 amended by adding at the end the following:

5 “(k) DRUGGED DRIVING PREVENTION PILOT PRO-  
6 GRAM.—

7 “(1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 1 year after  
8 the date of enactment of this subsection, the Sec-  
9 retary of Transportation, acting through the Admin-  
10 istrator of the National Highway Traffic Safety Ad-  
11 ministration, shall establish a pilot program to cre-  
12 ate, and study the effects of, a public marketing  
13 campaign to raise awareness on driving while under  
14 the influence of prescription and over-the-counter  
15 medications.

16 “(2) CONSULTATION.—In implementing the  
17 pilot program, the Secretary may consult with phar-  
18 macies, pharmaceutical companies, and govern-  
19 mental and nongovernmental organizations.

20 “(3) LOCATIONS.—The Secretary shall imple-  
21 ment the pilot program in States or territories that  
22 are most affected by the opioid epidemic.

23 “(4) SUNSET.—The pilot program shall termi-  
24 nate on the date that is 2 years after the date on  
25 which the pilot program is established.

1           “(5) REPORT.—Not later than 1 year after the  
2           date of termination of the pilot program, the Sec-  
3           retary shall submit to Congress a report on the re-  
4           sults of the study of the effects of the public mar-  
5           keting campaign.”.

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
