A BILL

To provide for the issuance and sale of a semipostal by the United States Postal Service for the fight against colorectal cancer.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. COLORECTAL CANCER SEMIPOSTAL.
- 4 (a) In General.—In order to contribute to the fight
- 5 against colorectal cancer, the United States Postal Service
- 6 shall provide for the issuance and sale of a semipostal,
- 7 in accordance with section 416 of title 39, United States
- 8 Code, subject to the following:

1	(1) DISPOSITION OF AMOUNTS.—Of the
2	amounts becoming available from the sale of the
3	semipostal—
4	(A) 40 percent shall be transferred to the
5	Department of Defense Peer Reviewed Medical
6	Research Program for colorectal cancer re-
7	search;
8	(B) 40 percent shall be transferred to the
9	Centers for Disease Control and Prevention for
10	colorectal cancer control programs; and
11	(C) the remainder shall be transferred to
12	the National Institutes of Health for colorectal
13	cancer research.
14	(2) Exclusion from numerical limita-
15	TION.—No semipostal issued pursuant to this Act
16	shall be taken into account for purposes of applying
17	any numerical limitation established under section
18	416(e)(1)(C) of title 39, United States Code.
19	(b) Definitions.—For purposes of this Act—
20	(1) the term "semipostal" has the meaning
21	given such term by section 416(a)(1) of title 39,
22	United States Code; and
23	(2) any determination of the "amounts becom-
24	ing available" from the sale of a semipostal shall be

- 1 made in accordance with section 416(d) of title 39,
- 2 United States Code.
