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## A BILL

To amend the Small Business Act to increase, prime contracting opportunities for small business concerns, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Preserving Small Busi-  
5       ness Prime Contracting Opportunities Act of 2022”.

6       **SEC. 2. INCREASING PRIME CONTRACTING OPPORTUNI-**  
7                   **TIES FOR SMALL BUSINESS CONCERNS.**

8       Section 15(a)(4) of the Small Business Act (15  
9       U.S.C. 644(a)(4)) is amended—

1                             (1) in subsection (A)(iii), by striking “an un-  
2 necessary or unjustified” and inserting “a”;

3                             (2) in subparagraph (B)—

4                                 (A) in the matter preceding clause (i), by  
5                                 striking “With respect to” and all that follows  
6                                 through “issuing a solicitation” and inserting  
7                                 “Not later than 30 days before issuing a solici-  
8                                 tation for a proposed procurement,”; and

9                                 (B) by amending clause (i) to read as fol-  
10                                 lows:

11                                 “(i) why the proposed procurement  
12                                 cannot be divided into smaller quantities,  
13                                 lots, or tasks to permit offers on less than

“(ii) DETERMINATION.—Not later than 60 calendar days after receipt of a notification under clause (i), such head shall adopt the selected alternative procurement method unless such head, on a nondelegable basis, issues a determination to the Administrator that includes—
