A BILL

To amend the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act to prohibit new labeling changes on use of registered pesticides without notice, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Farmers Deserve Noti-
5 fication Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. NO NEW RESTRICTIONS OF REGISTERED PES-**
2 **TICIDES WITHOUT NOTICE.**

3 Section 6(a) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide,
4 and Rodenticide Act (7 U.S.C. 136d(a)) is amended by
5 adding at the end the following:

6 “(3) NOTICE REQUIRED.—

7 “(A) IN GENERAL.—The Administrator
8 shall not cancel, suspend or restrict the use of
9 any pesticide registered under this Act without
10 providing, through publication in the Federal
11 Register, advance notice of such cancellation,
12 suspension, or restriction at least 270 days be-
13 fore such cancellation, suspension, or restriction
14 is to take effect.

15 “(B) NONAPPLICABILITY.—The 270-day
16 notification period specified in subparagraph
17 (A) shall not be required with respect to a pes-
18 ticide if a majority of the Scientific Advisory
19 Panel established under section 25(d)(1) votes
20 to not require such notification period with re-
21 spect to such pesticide.”.
