Mr. TORRES of New York introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To amend the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 to provide for the inclusion of an additional use of Byrne-JAG grant funds.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Bodega Owner Defense
5 Enhancement Grant Assistance Act of 2024” or as the
6 “BODEGA Act of 2024”.

1 **SEC. 2. INCLUSION OF ADDITIONAL USE OF GRANT**
2 **AMOUNTS.**

3 Section 501 of title I of the Omnibus Crime Control
4 and Safe Streets Act of 1968 (34 U.S.C. 10152) is amend-
5 ed—

6 (1) in subsection (a)(1), by adding at the the
7 end the following:

8 “(H) The installation of panic buttons,
9 and surveillance equipment in a private busi-
10 ness.”; and

11 (2) in subsection (b)—

12 (A) in paragraph (1), by striking “or” at
13 the end;

14 (B) in paragraph (2), by striking the pe-
15 riod at the end and inserting “; or”; and

16 (C) by adding at the end the following:

17 “(3) private businesses that are classified under
18 the North American Industrial Classification Code
19 445131.”.
