A BILL

To amend title 23, United States Code, to modify certain requirements of the railway-highway crossings program, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Railway Upgrades for
5 Rural American Lines Act” or the “RURAL Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. RAILWAY-HIGHWAY CROSSINGS PROGRAM.**

7 Section 130 of title 23, United States Code, is
8 amended—

9 (1) in subsection (e)(1)—

1 (A) in subparagraph (A) by striking “and
2 the installation of protective devices” and in-
3 serting “, the installation of protective devices,
4 and the replacement of functionally obsolete
5 warning devices”; and

6 (B) in subparagraph (B) by striking “the
7 installation of protective devices at railway-
8 highway crossings” and inserting “construction
9 or installation of protective devices (including
10 replacement of functionally obsolete protective
11 devices) at railway-highway crossings”;

12 (2) in subsection (f)(3) by striking “90 per-
13 cent” and inserting “100 percent”; and

14 (3) in subsection (i)(3)(B) by striking “\$7,500”
15 and inserting “\$100,000”.
