- 4 This Act may be cited as the "The Forgotten Funds
- 5 Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. RESCISSION OF UNOBLIGATED FUNDS.
- 7 (a) Rescission of Unobligated Funds.—The un-
- 8 obligated balances of the discretionary appropriations that
- 9 were made available in fiscal years 2008 and earlier are
- 10 rescinded.

- 1 (b) Use for Deficit Reduction.—The amounts
- 2 rescinded under subsection (a) shall be deposited in the
- 3 general fund of the Treasury and used for Federal budget

4 deficit reduction.
