1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE. 2 This Act may be cited as the "Taking Account of Bu-3 reaucrats' Spending Act of 2019" or the "TABS Act of 4 2019". 5 SEC. 2. BRINGING THE BUREAU INTO THE REGULAR AP-6 **PROPRIATIONS PROCESS.** 7 Section 1017 of the Consumer Financial Protection Act of 2010 (12 U.S.C. 5497) is amended— 8 9 (1) in subsection (a)— 10 (A) by amending the heading of such sub-11 section to read as follows: "BUDGET, FINAN-12 CIAL MANAGEMENT, AND AUDIT.—"; 13 (B) by striking paragraphs (1), (2), and (3);14 15 (C) by redesignating paragraphs (4) and 16 (5) as paragraphs (1) and (2), respectively; and 17 (D) by striking subparagraphs (E) and (F) 18 of paragraph (1), as so redesignated; 19 (2) by striking subsections (b) and (c); 20 (3) by redesignating subsections (d) and (e) as 21 subsections (b) and (c), respectively; and 22 (4) in subsection (c), as so redesignated— 23 (A) by striking paragraphs (1), (2), and 24 (3) and inserting the following: "(1) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.— 25 26 There are authorized to be appropriated such sums

as may be necessary to carry out this title for each
of fiscal years 2019 and 2020."; and
(B) by redesignating paragraph (4) as
paragraph (2).
