A BILL

To amend the Immigration and Nationality Act to provide for a minimum number of refugees who may be admitted in any fiscal year after fiscal year 2022, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Lady Liberty Act of
5 2021”.

6 **SEC. 2. MINIMUM NUMBER OF REFUGEES TO BE ADMITTED.**

7 Section 207(a) of the Immigration and Nationality
8 Act (8 U.S.C. 1157(a)) is amended by inserting after “in
9 any fiscal year after fiscal year 1982 shall be such number
10 as the President determines,” the following: “except that
11 in any fiscal year after fiscal year 2022, such number may
12 not be less than 125,000, without regard to whether or
13 not the President makes any determination”.

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
