To amend the Child Abuse Prevention and Treatment Act to authorize the Secretary of Health and Human Services to award grants for purposes of reducing child abuse and neglect due to the substance use disorder of a parent or caregiver.

1 **SECTION 1. REDUCING CHILD ABUSE AND NEGLECT DUE**
2 **TO THE SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER OF A**
3 **PARENT OR CAREGIVER.**

4 Section 105(a) of the Child Abuse Prevention and
5 Treatment Act (42 U.S.C. 5106(a)) is amended by adding
6 at the end the following:

7 “(8) REDUCING CHILD ABUSE AND NEGLECT
8 DUE TO THE SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER OF A PAR-
9 ENT OR CAREGIVER.—The Secretary may award
10 grants under this subsection to entities to carry out
11 activities to reduce child abuse and neglect due to
12 the substance use disorder of a parent or care-
13 giver.”.
