Mr. DELANEY submitted the following concurrent resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Foreign Affairs

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Expressing the sense of Congress that Warren Weinstein should be returned home to his family.

Whereas Warren Weinstein was abducted in Pakistan in 2011 and is currently being held captive by al-Qaeda;

Whereas Warren Weinstein is a former Peace Corps and former United States Agency for International Development official;

Whereas Warren Weinstein is widely recognized as a scholar and humanitarian who has spent his career working to improve the lives of men, women, and children around the world; and

Whereas video released of Warren Weinstein by his captors confirms that he is in poor health: Now, therefore, be it

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That it is the sense of Congress that the Ad-
3 ministration should—

4 (1) use all of the lawful tools at its disposal to
5 bring Warren Weinstein home to his family;

6 (2) make the return of all United States citi-
7 zens held captive abroad, regardless of their dif-
8 ferent circumstances, a top priority; and

9 (3) keep Congress apprised of its actions to
10 achieve these goals as new information is available,
11 or quarterly if no new information is available.
