3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This resolution may be cited as the "Fiscal State of5 the Nation Resolution".

6 SEC. 2. ANNUAL JOINT HEARING OF BUDGET COMMITTEES

- TO RECEIVE A PRESENTATION BY THE COMP-
- 8 TROLLER GENERAL.

1 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 45 days (excluding 2 Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays) after the date on which 3 the Secretary of the Treasury submits to Congress the au-4 dited financial statement required under paragraph (1) of 5 section 331(e) of title 31, United States Code, on a date 6 agreed upon by the chairs of the Committees on the Budg-7 et of the House of Representatives and the Senate (here-8 after referred to as the "Budget Committees") and the 9 Comptroller General of the United States, the Budget Committees shall hold a joint hearing (hereafter referred 10 to as the "Joint Hearing") to receive a presentation from 11 12 the Comptroller General reviewing the findings of the 13 audit required under paragraph (2) of such section and providing, with respect to the information included by the 14 15 Secretary in the report accompanying such audited financial statement, an analysis of the financial position and 16 17 condition of the Federal Government, including financial 18 measures (such as the net operating cost, income, budget 19 deficits, or budget surpluses) and sustainability measures 20(such as the long-term fiscal projection or social insurance 21 projection) described in such report.

(b) PRESENTATION OF STATEMENT IN ACCORDANCE
WITH GAO STRATEGIES AND MEANS.—The Comptroller
General of the United States shall ensure that the presentation at the Joint Hearing is made in accordance with

the Strategies and Means of the Government Account ability Office, so that the presentation will provide profes sional, objective, fact-based, nonpartisan, nonideological,
 fair, and balanced information to the members attending
 the Joint Hearing.

6 (c) RULES APPLICABLE TO JOINT HEARING.—

7 (1) IN GENERAL.—Except as provided in para8 graphs (2) and (3), the Joint Hearing shall be sub9 ject to rules agreed to by the chairs of the Budget
10 Committees.

(2) OPEN HEARING.—The Joint Hearing shall
be open to the public, including to radio, television,
and still photography coverage.

14 (3) ATTENDANCE.—The Joint Hearing shall
15 accommodate non-participatory attendance by any
16 Senator and any Member of the House of Represent17 atives, including any Delegate or Resident Commis18 sioner to the Congress.

19 (d) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The requirement under sub-20 section (a) shall apply with respect to any audited finan-

1 cial statement submitted on or after the date of the enact-

2 ment of this resolution.
