Mr. KING of New York (for himself, Mr. REICHERT, Mr. PASCRELL, and Mr. HOYER) submitted the following concurrent resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Authorizing the use of the Capitol Grounds for the 2nd
Annual Fallen Firefighters Congressional Flag Presenta-
tion Ceremony.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring),*

3 **SECTION 1. USE OF CAPITOL GROUNDS FOR FALLEN FIRE-**
4 **FIGHTERS CONGRESSIONAL FLAG PRESEN-**
5 **TATION CEREMONY.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Congressional Fire Services
7 Institute and the National Fallen Firefighters Foundation
8 (in this resolution referred to jointly as the “sponsor”)
9 shall be permitted to sponsor a public event, the 2nd An-

1 nual Fallen Firefighters Congressional Flag Presentation
2 Ceremony (in this resolution referred to as the “event”),
3 on the Capitol Grounds in order to honor the firefighters
4 who died in the line of duty in 2014.

5 (b) DATE OF EVENT.—The event shall be held on
6 September 30, 2015, or on such other date as the Speaker
7 of the House of Representatives and the Committee on
8 Rules and Administration of the Senate jointly designate.

9 **SEC. 2. TERMS AND CONDITIONS.**

10 (a) IN GENERAL.—Under conditions to be prescribed
11 by the Architect of the Capitol and the Capitol Police
12 Board, the event shall be—

13 (1) free of admission charge and open to the
14 public; and

15 (2) arranged not to interfere with the needs of
16 Congress.

17 (b) EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES.—The sponsor shall
18 assume full responsibility for all expenses and liabilities
19 incident to all activities associated with the event.

20 **SEC. 3. EVENT PREPARATIONS.**

21 Subject to the approval of the Architect of the Cap-
22 itol, the sponsor is authorized to erect upon the Capitol
23 Grounds such stage, sound amplification devices, and
24 other related structures and equipment as may be required
25 for the event.

1 **SEC. 4. ADDITIONAL ARRANGEMENTS.**

2 The Architect of the Capitol and the Capitol Police
3 Board are authorized to make such additional arrange-
4 ments as may be required to carry out the event.

5 **SEC. 5. ENFORCEMENT OF RESTRICTIONS.**

6 The Capitol Police Board shall provide for enforce-
7 ment of the restrictions contained in section 5104(c) of
8 title 40, United States Code, concerning sales, advertise-
9 ments, displays, and solicitations on the Capitol Grounds,
10 as well as other restrictions applicable to the Capitol
11 Grounds, with respect to the event.

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
