JOINT RESOLUTION

Providing for congressional disapproval of the proposed foreign military sale to the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia of certain defense articles and services.

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the issuance of a license to export with respect to
4 the following proposed export to the Kingdom of Saudi
5 Arabia is hereby prohibited:

6 (1) The sale of the following defense articles
7 and services, described in Transmittal No. 23–15,
8 submitted to Congress pursuant to section 36(b)(1)
9 of the Arms Export Control Act (22 U.S.C.
10 2776(b)(1)): seven (7) Embedded Global Positioning

1 System/Inertial Navigation System (GPS/INS)
2 (EGI) security devices, Airborne, with Selective
3 Availability Anti-Spoofing Module (SAASM) or M-
4 Code capability, and five (5) L3Harris BlackRock
5 Communications Intelligence Sensor Suites. Also in-
6 cluded are KY-100M narrowband/wideband secure
7 communications terminals; KIV-77 MODE 4/5
8 Identification Friend or Foe (IFF) cryptographic
9 appliques; AN/PYQ-10 Simple Key Loaders; inte-
10 grated electronic intelligence (ELINT)/signals intel-
11 ligence (SIGINT) systems; L-3 Communication Sys-
12 tems-West (CSW) multiband receivers/transmitters;
13 ARC-210 radios; high frequency (HF) radios; se-
14 cure communications equipment; precision naviga-
15 tion and cryptographic devices; aircraft support and
16 support equipment; test and integration support;
17 equipment; spare and repair parts; consumables and
18 accessories; repair and return support; United States
19 Government and contractor engineering, technical,
20 and logistics support services; studies and surveys;
21 and other related elements of logistics and program
22 support.
