Mr. RIBBLE introduced the following joint resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Appropriations

## JOINT RESOLUTION

Making continuing appropriations for the Transportation Security Administration for fiscal year 2015, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*  
2       *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3       That the following sums are hereby appropriated, out of  
4       any money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated,  
5       and out of applicable corporate or other revenues, receipts,  
6       and funds, for the Transportation Security Administration  
7       for fiscal year 2015, and for other purposes, namely:

8       SEC. 101. (a) Such amounts as may be necessary,  
9       at a rate for operations as provided for fiscal year 2014  
10      under the Department of Homeland Security Appropria-

1 tions Act, 2014 (division F of Public Law 113–76) and  
2 under the authority and conditions provided in such Act,  
3 for continuing projects or activities (including the costs  
4 of direct loans and loan guarantees) that are not otherwise  
5 specifically provided for in this joint resolution, that were  
6 conducted in fiscal year 2014, and for which appropria-  
7 tions, funds, or other authority were made available by  
8 such Act under the heading “Transportation Security Ad-  
9 ministration”.

10       SEC. 102. Appropriations made by section 101 shall  
11 be available to the extent and in the manner that would  
12 be provided by the pertinent appropriations Act.

13       SEC. 103. Unless otherwise provided for in this joint  
14 resolution or in the applicable appropriations Act for fiscal  
15 year 2015, appropriations and funds made available and  
16 authority granted pursuant to this joint resolution shall  
17 be available until whichever of the following first occurs:  
18 (1) the enactment into law of an appropriation for any  
19 project or activity provided for in this joint resolution; (2)  
20 the enactment into law of the applicable appropriations  
21 Act for fiscal year 2015 without any provision for such  
22 project or activity; or (3) September 30, 2015.

23       SEC. 104. Expenditures made pursuant to this joint  
24 resolution shall be charged to the applicable appropriation,  
25 fund, or authorization whenever a bill in which such appli-

1 cable appropriation, fund, or authorization is contained is  
2 enacted into law.

3 SEC. 105. This joint resolution shall be implemented  
4 so that only the most limited funding action of that per-  
5 mitted in the joint resolution shall be taken in order to  
6 provide for continuation of projects and activities.

7 SEC. 106. Amounts made available under section 101  
8 for civilian personnel compensation and benefits in each  
9 department and agency may be apportioned up to the rate  
10 for operations necessary to avoid furloughs within such de-  
11 partment or agency, consistent with the applicable appro-  
12 priations Act for fiscal year 2014, except that such author-  
13 ity provided under this section shall not be used until after  
14 the department or agency has taken all necessary actions  
15 to reduce or defer non-personnel-related administrative ex-  
16 penses.

17 This joint resolution may be cited as the “Transportation Security Administration Continuing Appropriations  
18 Resolution, 2015”.
