JOINT RESOLUTION

Providing for congressional disapproval of the proposed direct commercial sale to Israel of certain weaponry and munitions.

- 1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
 2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
 3 That the issuance of a license for the export with respect
 4 to any of the following transfers to Israel is prohibited:
- 5 (1) The transfer of the following defense arti-
 6 cles, including defense services and technical data,
 7 described in license document DDTC 20–084, sub-
 8 mitted to Congress pursuant to section 36(c) of the

1 Arms Export Control Act (22 U.S.C. 2776(c)) on
2 May 5, 2021: The proposed transfer of defense arti-
3 cles, defense services, and technical data to support
4 weapons integration, flight test, and hardware deliv-
5 ery of Joint Direct Attack Munition variants and
6 Small Diameter Bomb Increment I variants for end-
7 use by the Ministry of Defense for Israel.
