2 "SECTION 1. No person shall be a Representative for
3 more than eighteen years, except that service to fill a va4 cancy shall not be included in determining eligibility.

5 "SECTION 2. No person shall be a Senator for more6 than eighteen years, except that service to fill a vacancy7 shall not be included in determining eligibility.

8 "SECTION 3. Only service that begins after the date
9 of ratification of this article shall count in determining the
10 number of years a Representative or Senator serves.".
