RESOLUTION

Amending the Rules of the House of Representatives to require a three-fifths vote on a stand-alone bill to increase the statutory limit on the public debt.

- 1 Resolved, That rule XXVIII of the Rules of the House
- 2 of Representatives (relating to the statutory limit on the
- 3 public debt) is amended by striking clauses 1 through 4,
- 4 by redesignating clause 5 as clause 3, and by inserting
- 5 before clause 3 the following new clauses:
- 6 "1. It shall not be in order to consider any bill or
- 7 joint resolution, or amendment thereto or conference re-
- 8 port thereon, that increases the statutory limit on the pub-
- 9 lie debt if there is any other matter in such measure.

- 1 "2. A bill or joint resolution, or amendment thereto
- 2 or conference report thereon, that increases the statutory
- 3 limit on the public debt may not be considered as passed
- 4 or agreed to unless so determined by a vote of not less
- 5 than three-fifths of the Members voting, a quorum being

6 present.".
