RESOLUTION

Of inquiry directing the President to provide certain documents in the President's possession to the House of Representatives relating to COVID–19 funding.

1 *Resolved*, That, not later than 14 days after the adop-
2 tion of this resolution, the President is directed to furnish
3 to the House of Representatives copies of any document
4 or communication in the President's possession that refers
5 or relates to—

1 (1) the data, modeling, and projections used by
2 the President to develop the COVID–19 supple-
3 mental funding request in the spring of 2022, in-
4 cluding—

5 (A) COVID–19 funding that was available,
6 and not obligated or expended, as of developing
7 such request;

8 (B) any projections related to the number
9 of COVID–19 cases and hospitalizations associ-
10 ated with such request; and

11 (C) any projections for the number of
12 COVID–19 tests, vaccines, and therapeutics to
13 be paid for by the Federal Government;

14 (2) an accounting of funds that were made
15 available by the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021
16 (Public Law 117–138) and have not been obligated
17 or expended; or

18 (3) an accounting of funds obligated or ex-
19 pended by the executive branch for COVID–19 at-
20 home test kits.
