RESOLUTION

Of inquiry directing the Administrator of the Small Business Administration to transmit certain documents to the House of Representatives relating to actions by the Small Business Administration to address fraud related to certain COVID–19 programs of the Administration.

1 *Resolved*, That the Administrator of the Small Busi-
2 ness Administration is directed to transmit to the House
3 of Representatives, not later than 14 days after the date
4 of the adoption of this resolution, copies of any document,
5 memorandum, correspondence, and other communication
6 or any portion of any such communication, that refers or
7 relates to the actions taken by the Small Business Admin-

1 istration relating to the announcement by the Adminis-
2 trator on April 1, 2022, titled “Administrator Guzman
3 Announces Expanded Efforts to Aggressively Crack Down
4 on Bad Actors and Prevent Fraud in Programs” (Release
5 Number 22–31), including the following:

6 (1) The names and titles of each individual cur-
7 rently on the Enterprise Risk Management Board of
8 the Administration.

9 (2) The names and titles of each individual cur-
10 rently on the Fraud Risk Management Board of the
11 Administration.

12 (3) The names and titles of each individual who
13 served on the Compliance, Oversight, and Reporting
14 Team board of the Administration.

15 (4) The names and titles of each individual who
16 served on the Fraud Risk Management Council of
17 the Administration.

18 (5) All documents and communications relating
19 to the amount of funds from loans made under sec-
20 tion 7(b) of the Small Business Act (15 U.S.C.
21 636(b)) in response to COVID–19, grants under sec-
22 tion 1110(e) of the CARES Act (15 U.S.C.
23 9009(e)), and grants under section 331 of the Eco-
24 nomic Aid to Hard-Hit Small Businesses, Non-
25 profits, and Venues Act (15 U.S.C. 9009b) that the

1 Administration has recovered from individuals and
2 entities that fraudulently obtained such loans and
3 grants.
