RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1120) to prohibit the National Labor Relations Board from taking any action that requires a quorum of the members of the Board until such time as Board constituting a quorum shall have been confirmed by the Senate, the Supreme Court issues a decision on the constitutionality of the appointments to the Board made in January 2012, or the adjournment sine die of the first session of the 113th Congress.

1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution
2 it shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.
3 1120) to prohibit the National Labor Relations Board
4 from taking any action that requires a quorum of the
5 members of the Board until such time as Board consti-
6 tuting a quorum shall have been confirmed by the Senate,
7 the Supreme Court issues a decision on the constitu-
8 tionality of the appointments to the Board made in Janu-
9 ary 2012, or the adjournment sine die of the first session
10 of the 113th Congress. All points of order against consid-
11 eration of the bill are waived. In lieu of the amendment
12 in the nature of a substitute recommended by the Com-
13 mittee on Education and the Workforce now printed in
14 the bill, an amendment in the nature of a substitute con-
15 sisting of the text of Rules Committee Print 113-6, shall
16 be considered as adopted. The bill, as amended, shall be
17 considered as read. All points of order against provisions
18 in the bill, as amended, are waived. The previous question
19 shall be considered as ordered on the bill, as amended,
20 and on any further amendment thereto, to final passage
21 without intervening motion except: (1) one hour of debate
22 equally divided and controlled by the chair and ranking
23 minority member of the Committee on Education and the
24 Workforce; and (2) one motion to recommit with or with-
25 out instructions.
