# RESOLUTION

1       *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it  
2 shall be in order to take from the Speaker's table the bill  
3 (H.R. 8404) to repeal the Defense of Marriage Act and  
4 ensure respect for State regulation of marriage, and for  
5 other purposes, with the Senate amendment thereto, and  
6 to consider in the House, without intervention of any point

1 of order, a motion offered by the chair of the Committee  
2 on the Judiciary or his designee that the House concur  
3 in the Senate amendment. The Senate amendment and the  
4 motion shall be considered as read. The motion shall be  
5 debatable for one hour equally divided and controlled by  
6 the chair and ranking minority member of the Committee  
7 on the Judiciary or their respective designees. The pre-  
8 vious question shall be considered as ordered on the mo-  
9 tion to its adoption without intervening motion.
