RESOLUTION

Calling for the designation of Mexican drug cartels as foreign terrorist organizations.

- 1 *Resolved*, That the House of Representatives—
- 2 (1) condemns the Sinaloa Cartel, the Jalisco
- 3 New Generation Cartel, the Beltran-Levya Cartel,
- 4 the Gulf Cartel, the Los Zetas, the Tijuana Cartel,
- 5 the La Familia Michoacana/Knights Templar Cartel,
- 6 and any similarly situated Mexican drug cartels;
- 7 (2) calls for the designation of the Sinaloa Car-
- 8 tel, the Jalisco New Generation Cartel, the Beltran-
- 9 Levya Cartel, the Gulf Cartel, the Los Zetas, the Ti-
- 10 juana Cartel, the La Familia Michoacana/Knights

1 Templar Cartel, and any similarly situated Mexican
2 drug cartels as foreign terrorist organizations under
3 section 219 of the Immigration and Nationality Act
4 (8 U.S.C. 1189); and

5 (3) calls for the Biden Administration to freeze
6 cartel financial assets and allow Federal investiga-
7 tors and prosecutors to pursue enhanced criminal
8 sentences that apply to drug traffickers who fund
9 foreign terrorist organizations.
