Mr. CARDOZA, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 626) to provide that 4 of the 12 weeks of parental leave made available to a Federal employee shall be paid leave, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 626) to provide that 4 of the 12
6 weeks of parental leave made available to a Federal em-

1 ployee shall be paid leave, and for other purposes. The
2 first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points
3 of order against consideration of the bill are waived except
4 those arising under clause 9 or 10 of rule XXI. General
5 debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not exceed
6 one hour equally divided and controlled by the chair and
7 ranking minority member of the Committee on Oversight
8 and Government Reform. After general debate the bill
9 shall be considered for amendment under the five-minute
10 rule. The bill shall be considered as read. All points of
11 order against provisions in the bill are waived. Notwith-
12 standing clause 11 of rule XVIII, no amendment to the
13 bill shall be in order except those printed in the report
14 of the Committee on Rules accompanying this resolution.
15 Each such amendment may be offered only in the order
16 printed in the report, may be offered only by a Member
17 designated in the report, shall be considered as read, shall
18 be debatable for the time specified in the report equally
19 divided and controlled by the proponent and an opponent,
20 shall not be subject to amendment, and shall not be sub-
21 ject to a demand for division of the question in the House
22 or in the Committee of the Whole. All points of order
23 against such amendments are waived except those arising
24 under clause 9 or 10 of rule XXI. At the conclusion of
25 consideration of the bill for amendment the Committee

1 shall rise and report the bill to the House with such
2 amendments as may have been adopted. The previous
3 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and
4 amendments thereto to final passage without intervening
5 motion except one motion to recommit with or without in-
6 structions.
