Mr. MCGOVERN, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for further consideration of the bill (H.R. 384) to reform the Troubled Assets Relief Program of the Secretary of the Treasury and ensure accountability under such Program, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for further
5 consideration of the bill (H.R. 384) to reform the Trou-
6 bled Assets Relief Program of the Secretary of the Treas-

1 ury and ensure accountability under such Program. No
2 further general debate shall be in order. The bill shall be
3 considered for amendment under the five-minute rule. The
4 bill shall be considered as read. All points of order against
5 provisions in the bill are waived. Notwithstanding clause
6 11 of rule XVIII, no amendment to the bill shall be in
7 order except those printed in the report of the Committee
8 on Rules accompanying this resolution. Each such amend-
9 ment may be offered only in the order printed in the re-
10 port, may be offered only by a Member designated in the
11 report, shall be considered as read, shall be debatable for
12 the time specified in the report equally divided and con-
13 trolled by the proponent and an opponent, shall not be
14 subject to amendment, and shall not be subject to a de-
15 mand for division of the question in the House or in the
16 Committee of the Whole. All points of order against such
17 amendments are waived except those arising under clause
18 9 or 10 of rule XXI. At the conclusion of consideration
19 of the bill for amendment the Committee shall rise and
20 report the bill to the House with such amendments as may
21 have been adopted. The previous question shall be consid-
22 ered as ordered on the bill and any amendments thereto
23 to final passage without intervening motion except one
24 motion to recommit with or without instructions.

1 SEC. 2. A motion to proceed under section 115 of
2 the Emergency Economic Stabilization Act of 2008—

3 (a) shall be in order only if offered by the Majority
4 Leader or his designee; and

5 (b) may be offered even following the sixth day speci-
6 fied in subsection (d)(3) of such section but not later than
7 the legislative day of January 22, 2009.

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
