RESOLUTION

Providing for the consideration of the bill (S. 820) to strengthen programs authorized under the Debbie Smith Act of 2004.

1 *Resolved*, That immediately upon adoption of this res-
2 olution, the House shall proceed to the consideration in
3 the House of the bill (S. 820) to strengthen programs au-
4 thorized under the Debbie Smith Act of 2004. All points
5 of order against consideration of the bill are waived. The
6 bill shall be considered as read. All points of order against
7 provisions in the bill are waived. The previous question
8 shall be considered as ordered on the bill and on any

1 amendment thereto to final passage without intervening
2 motion except: (1) one hour of debate equally divided and
3 controlled by the chair and ranking minority member of
4 the Committee on the Judiciary; and (2) one motion to
5 recommit.

6 SEC. 2. Clause 1(c) of rule XIX shall not apply to
7 the consideration of S. 820.
