Mr. BIGGS (for himself and Mr. ROSENDALE) submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Rules

RESOLUTION

Providing for the consideration of the bill (H. R. 1259) to direct the Secretary of Homeland Security to continue to implement the Migrant Protection Protocols, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That immediately upon adoption of this res-
2 olution, the House shall proceed to the consideration in
3 the House of the bill (H. R. 1259) to direct the Secretary
4 of Homeland Security to continue to implement the Mi-
5 grant Protection Protocols, and for other purposes. All
6 points of order against consideration of the bill are waived.
7 The bill shall be considered as read. All points of order
8 against provisions in the bill are waived. The previous

1 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and on
2 any amendment thereto to final passage without inter-
3 vening motion except: (1) one hour of debate equally di-
4 vided and controlled by the majority leader and the minor-
5 ity leader or their respective designees; and (2) one motion
6 to recommit.

7 SEC. 2. Clause 1(c) of rule XIX shall not apply to
8 the consideration of H. R. 1259.
