RESOLUTION

Honoring Chris Mazdzer of Saranac Lake, New York, for proudly representing the United States in three consecutive Olympic Winter Games.

Whereas, on Sunday, February 11, 2018, Chris Mazdzer competed in his third Olympic Winter Games in Pyeongchang, South Korea, where he won the silver medal in the men's singles luge; and

Whereas Chris Mazdzer is the first American men's singles luge medalist and is the first and currently only non-European to win a medal in the men's singles luge: Now, therefore, be it

1 *Resolved*, That the House of Representatives—

1 (1) congratulates and honors Chris Mazdzer
2 and his hometown of Saranac Lake, New York, on
3 his performance at the XXIII Olympic Winter
4 Games in Pyeongchang, South Korea;

5 (2) recognizes and commends the hard work,
6 dedication, determination, and commitment to excel-
7 lence of Chris Mazdzer for skillfully representing the
8 United States at three consecutive Olympic Winter
9 Games; and

10 (3) recognizes and commends the people of
11 Saranac Lake, New York, and the surrounding com-
12 munities for their loyalty and support of Chris
13 Mazdzer throughout his Olympic and international
