3 lating to access to business records, individual terrorists  
4 as agents of foreign powers, and roving wiretaps until De-  
5 cember 8, 2011. All points of order against consideration  
6 of the bill are waived. The bill shall be considered as read.  
7 All points of order against provisions in the bill are  
8 waived. The previous question shall be considered as or-  
9 dered on the bill to final passage without intervening mo-  
10 tion except: (1) one hour of debate, with 40 minutes equal-  
11 ly divided and controlled by the chair and ranking minor-  
12 ity member of the Committee on the Judiciary and 20  
13 minutes equally divided and controlled by the chair and  
14 ranking minority member of the Permanent Select Com-  
15 mittee on Intelligence; and (2) one motion to recommit.
