## RESOLUTION

Amending the Rules of the House of Representatives to prohibit the consideration of a bill or joint resolution, or any amendment thereto or conference report thereon, that includes reconciliation legislation prior to the receipt by the committee of jurisdiction of the cost analysis for such legislation from the Congressional Budget Office.

1      *Resolved,*

1 **SECTION 1. REQUIREMENT FOR RECONCILIATION LEGIS-**  
2 **LATION IN HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.**

3 Clause 10 of rule XVIII of the Rules of the House  
4 of Representatives is amended by adding at the end the  
5 following new paragraph:

6 “(d) It shall not be in order in the House or in the  
7 Committee of the Whole House on the state of the Union  
8 to consider any reconciliation bill or reconciliation joint  
9 resolution, or any amendment thereto or conference report  
10 thereon, that carries out reconciliation directives included  
11 in a concurrent resolution on the budget adopted under  
12 section 301 or section 304 of the Congressional Budget  
13 Act of 1974 prior to the receipt by the committee of juris-  
14 diction with respect to the reconciliation legislation of the  
15 estimate and comparison of costs prepared by the Director  
16 of the Congressional Budget Office under section 402 of  
17 such Act for such reconciliation legislation.”.
