Mr. WOODALL, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

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# RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the Senate amendment to the bill (H.R. 3249) to authorize the Project Safe Neighborhoods Grant Program, and for other purposes; providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 8) to provide for improvements to the rivers and harbors of the United States, to provide for the conservation and development of water and related resources, and for other purposes; and providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 5895)

making appropriations for energy and water development and related agencies for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2019, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it  
2 shall be in order to take from the Speaker's table the bill  
3 (H.R. 3249) to authorize the Project Safe Neighborhoods  
4 Grant Program, and for other purposes, with the Senate  
5 amendment thereto, and to consider in the House, without  
6 intervention of any point of order, a motion offered by the  
7 chair of the Committee on the Judiciary or his designee  
8 that the House concur in the Senate amendment. The  
9 Senate amendment and the motion shall be considered as  
10 read. The motion shall be debatable for one hour equally  
11 divided and controlled by the chair and ranking minority  
12 member of the Committee on the Judiciary. The previous  
13 question shall be considered as ordered on the motion to  
14 adoption without intervening motion.

15       SEC. 2. At any time after adoption of this resolution  
16 the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of rule XVIII,  
17 declare the House resolved into the Committee of the  
18 Whole House on the state of the Union for consideration  
19 of the bill (H.R. 8) to provide for improvements to the  
20 rivers and harbors of the United States, to provide for  
21 the conservation and development of water and related re-  
22 sources, and for other purposes. The first reading of the  
23 bill shall be dispensed with. All points of order against

1 consideration of the bill are waived. General debate shall  
2 be confined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour equal-  
3 ly divided and controlled by the chair and ranking minor-  
4 ity member of the Committee on Transportation and In-  
5 frastructure. After general debate the bill shall be consid-  
6 ered for amendment under the five-minute rule. In lieu  
7 of the amendment in the nature of a substitute rec-  
8 ommended by the Committee on Transportation and In-  
9 frastructure now printed in the bill, an amendment in the  
10 nature of a substitute consisting of the text of Rules Com-  
11 mittee Print 115-72 shall be considered as adopted in the  
12 House and in the Committee of the Whole. The bill, as  
13 amended, shall be considered as the original bill for the  
14 purpose of further amendment under the five-minute rule  
15 and shall be considered as read. All points of order against  
16 provisions in the bill, as amended, are waived. No further  
17 amendment to the bill, as amended, shall be in order ex-  
18 cept those printed in part A of the report of the Com-  
19 mittee on Rules accompanying this resolution. Each such  
20 further amendment may be offered only in the order print-  
21 ed in the report, may be offered only by a Member des-  
22 ignated in the report, shall be considered as read, shall  
23 be debatable for the time specified in the report equally  
24 divided and controlled by the proponent and an opponent,  
25 shall not be subject to amendment, and shall not be sub-

1 ject to a demand for division of the question in the House  
2 or in the Committee of the Whole. All points of order  
3 against such further amendments are waived. At the con-  
4 clusion of consideration of the bill for amendment the  
5 Committee shall rise and report the bill, as amended, to  
6 the House with such further amendments as may have  
7 been adopted. The previous question shall be considered  
8 as ordered on the bill, as amended, and on any further  
9 amendment thereto to final passage without intervening  
10 motion except one motion to recommit with or without in-  
11 structions.

12       SEC. 3. At any time after adoption of this resolution  
13 the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of rule XVIII,  
14 declare the House resolved into the Committee of the  
15 Whole House on the state of the Union for consideration  
16 of the bill (H.R. 5895) making appropriations for energy  
17 and water development and related agencies for the fiscal  
18 year ending September 30, 2019, and for other purposes.  
19 The first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. All  
20 points of order against consideration of the bill are waived.  
21 General debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not  
22 exceed one hour equally divided and controlled by the chair  
23 and ranking minority member of the Committee on Appro-  
24 priations. After general debate the bill shall be considered  
25 for amendment under the five-minute rule. An amendment

1 in the nature of a substitute consisting of the text of Rules  
2 Committee Print 115-71 shall be considered as adopted  
3 in the House and in the Committee of the Whole. The  
4 bill, as amended, shall be considered as the original bill  
5 for the purpose of further amendment under the five-  
6 minute rule and shall be considered as read. Points of  
7 order against provisions in the bill, as amended, for failure  
8 to comply with clause 2 of rule XXI are waived except  
9 as follows: page 66, line 14, through page 66, line 20. No  
10 further amendment to the bill, as amended, shall be in  
11 order except those printed in part B of the report of the  
12 Committee on Rules and pro forma amendments described  
13 in section 4 of this resolution. Each further amendment  
14 printed in part B of the report shall be considered only  
15 in the order printed in the report, may be offered only  
16 by a Member designated in the report, shall be considered  
17 as read, shall be debatable for the time specified in the  
18 report equally divided and controlled by the proponent and  
19 an opponent, may be withdrawn by the proponent at any  
20 time before action thereon, shall not be subject to amend-  
21 ment except as provided by section 4 of this resolution,  
22 and shall not be subject to a demand for division of the  
23 question in the House or in the Committee of the Whole.  
24 All points of order against such further amendments are  
25 waived. At the conclusion of consideration of the bill for

1 amendment pursuant to this resolution, the Committee of  
2 the Whole shall rise without motion. No further consider-  
3 ation of the bill shall be in order except pursuant to a  
4 subsequent order of the House.

5       SEC. 4. During consideration of H.R. 5895 for  
6 amendment, the chair and ranking minority member of  
7 the Committee on Appropriations or their respective des-  
8 ignees may offer up to 10 pro forma amendments each  
9 at any point for the purpose of debate.

10       SEC. 5. (a) During consideration of H.R. 5895, it  
11 shall not be in order to consider an amendment proposing  
12 both a decrease in an appropriation designated pursuant  
13 to section 251(b)(2)(A)(ii) of the Balanced Budget and  
14 Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985 and an increase  
15 in an appropriation not so designated, or vice versa. (b)  
16 This paragraph shall not apply to an amendment between  
17 the Houses.



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
