Mr. Barrett of South Carolina submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Rules

RESOLUTION

Amending the Rules of the House of Representatives to require a vote each year on whether to increase Members' pay.

- 1 Resolved, That rule XXI of the Rules of the House
- 2 of Representatives is amended by adding at the end the
- 3 following new clause:
- 4 "11. (a) During consideration in the Committee of
- 5 the Whole of a bill making appropriations for the Depart-
- 6 ment of the Treasury for any fiscal year, before consider-
- 7 ation of any other amendment, it shall be in order to con-
- 8 sider an amendment only proposing to bar the automatic
- 9 annual cost-of-living pay adjustment of Members of Con-
- 10 gress that would otherwise take effect in such fiscal year.

- 1 Such amendment shall be considered as read, shall not
- 2 be subject to amendment, and shall not be subject to a
- 3 demand for division of the question in the House or the
- 4 Committee of the Whole. All points of order against such
- 5 amendment are waived.
- 6 "(b) During consideration of a bill, conference report,
- 7 or amendment between the two Houses making or con-
- 8 tinuing appropriations to the end of a fiscal year that in-
- 9 cludes appropriations for the Department of the Treasury
- 10 for that fiscal year, it shall not be in order to consider
- 11 such measure unless (1) the measure includes a provision
- 12 to bar the automatic annual cost-of-living pay adjustment
- 13 of Members of Congress that would otherwise take effect
- 14 in such fiscal year or (2) the rule providing for its consid-
- 15 eration allows a vote proposing to bar such automatic an-
- 16 nual cost-of-living pay adjustment.".
