A BILL

To require the Director of the Office of Entrepreneurship Education of the Small Business Administration to establish and maintain a website regarding small business permitting and licensing requirements, and for other purposes.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “One Stop Shop for
5 Small Business Licensing Act of 2023”.

1 **SEC. 2. CENTRALIZED WEBSITE FOR BUSINESS PERMIT**
2 **AND LICENSING REQUIREMENTS.**

3 (a) DEFINITIONS.—In this section—

4 (1) the term “Director” means the Director of
5 the Office of Entrepreneurship Education of the
6 Small Business Administration; and

7 (2) the term “small business concern” has the
8 meaning given the term in section 3(a) of the Small
9 Business Act (15 U.S.C. 632(a)).

10 (b) WEBSITE.—Not later than 1 year after the date
11 of enactment of this Act, the Director shall establish, and
12 thereafter the Director shall maintain, a publicly available
13 website that provides information regarding Federal,
14 State, and local business permitting and licensing require-
15 ments with respect to the operation of a small business
16 concern, which shall be organized based on the location
17 and type of small business concern.
