A BILL

To prohibit Federal agencies from establishing policies that prohibit the service of particular types of food in dining facilities of agencies.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Telling Agencies to
5 Stop Tweaking what Employees Eat Act of 2021” or the
6 “TASTEE Act of 2021”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON DINING FACILITIES.**

2 (a) DEFINITION OF AGENCY.—In this section, the
3 term “agency” has the meaning given the term in section
4 551 of title 5, United States Code.

5 (b) PROHIBITION.—An agency, or a contractor of an
6 agency that provides food services to a dining facility of
7 the agency, may not establish a policy that prohibits a din-
8 ing facility of the agency from serving a particular type
9 of food.

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
