A BILL

To amend title 18, United States Code, to provide enhanced penalties for convicted murderers who kill or target America’s public safety officers.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Thin Blue Line Act”.

5 **SEC. 2. AGGRAVATING FACTORS FOR DEATH PENALTY.**

6 Section 3592(c) of title 18, United States Code, is
7 amended by inserting after paragraph (16) the following:

1 “(17) KILLING OR TARGETING OF LAW EN-
2 FORCEMENT OFFICER.—

3 “(A) The defendant killed or attempted to
4 kill, in the circumstance described in subpara-
5 graph (B), a person who is authorized by law—

6 “(i) to engage in or supervise the pre-
7 vention, detention, investigation, or pros-
8 ecution, or the incarceration of any person
9 for any criminal violation of law;

10 “(ii) to apprehend, arrest, or pros-
11 ecute an individual for any criminal viola-
12 tion of law; or

13 “(iii) to be a firefighter or other first
14 responder.

15 “(B) The circumstance referred to in sub-
16 paragraph (A) is that the person was killed or
17 targeted—

18 “(i) while he or she was engaged in
19 the performance of his or her official du-
20 ties;

21 “(ii) because of the performance of his
22 or her official duties; or

23 “(iii) because of his or her status as
24 a public official or employee.”.
