Mr. REID (for himself and Mr. HELLER) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To amend the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 to include court security officers in the public safety officers' death benefits program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Stanley Cooper Death
5 Benefits for Court Security Officers Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICERS' DEATH BENEFITS.**

7 Section 1204(9) of the Omnibus Crime Control and
8 Safe Streets Act of 1968 (42 U.S.C. 3796b(9)) is amend-
9 ed—

1 (1) in subparagraph (C)(ii), by striking “; or”
2 and inserting a semicolon;

3 (2) in subparagraph (D), by striking the period
4 and inserting “; or”; and

5 (3) by adding at the end the following:

6 “(E) a court security officer who is under
7 contract with the United States Marshals Serv-
8 ice.”.

9 **SEC. 3. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

10 There are authorized to be appropriated \$1,000,000
11 for each fiscal year to carry out the amendments made
12 by this Act.

13 **SEC. 4. APPLICABILITY.**

14 The amendments made by this Act shall apply to any
15 injury sustained on or after January 1, 2010.

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
