A BILL

To require each agency, in providing notice of a rulemaking, to include a link to a 100-word plain language summary of the proposed rule.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Providing Account-
5 ability Through Transparency Act of 2023”.

1 **SEC. 2. REQUIREMENT TO POST A 100-WORD SUMMARY TO**
2 **REGULATIONS.GOV.**

3 Section 553(b) of title 5, United States Code, is
4 amended—

5 (1) in paragraph (2), by striking “and” at the
6 end;

7 (2) in paragraph (3), by striking the period at
8 the end and inserting “; and”; and

9 (3) by inserting after paragraph (3) the fol-
10 lowing:

11 “(4) the Internet address of a summary of not
12 more than 100 words in length of the proposed rule,
13 in plain language, that shall be posted on the Inter-
14 net website under section 206(d) of the E-Govern-
15 ment Act of 2002 (44 U.S.C. 3501 note) (commonly
16 known as regulations.gov).”.
