A BILL

To amend the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961 to require the annual human rights reports to include information on the institutionalization of children and the subjection of children to cruel, inhuman, or degrading treatment, unnecessary detention, and denial of the right to life, liberty, and the security of persons.

1 **SECTION 1. INCLUSION IN ANNUAL COUNTRY REPORTS ON**
2 **HUMAN RIGHTS PRACTICES OF INFORMA-**
3 **TION ON CHILDREN LIVING WITHOUT FAMI-**
4 **LIES.**

5 Section 116(d) of the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961
6 (22 U.S.C. 2151n(d)) is amended—

7 (1) in paragraph (11)(C), by striking “and” at
8 the end;

9 (2) in paragraph (12)(C)(ii), by striking the pe-
10 riod at the end and inserting “; and”; and

11 (3) by adding at the end the following:

12 “(13)(A) the institutionalization of children in
13 orphanages and large and small group homes, when
14 such institutionalization can be avoided by prompt-
15 ly—

16 “(i) reunifying children with nurturing
17 parents of origin; or

18 “(ii) placing them in adoptive homes in the
19 country of origin or abroad; and

20 “(B) the related subjection of children to—

21 “(i) cruel, inhuman, or degrading treat-
22 ment;

23 “(ii) unnecessary detention; or

24 “(iii) the denial of the right to life, liberty,
25 and the security of persons.”.

1 **SEC. 2. DELAYED EFFECTIVE DATE.**

2 This Act shall take effect on the date that is one year
3 after the date of the enactment of this Act.
