## A BILL

To amend the Federal Lands Recreation Enhancement Act to provide for a lifetime National Recreational Pass for any veteran with a service-connected disability.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Wounded Veterans  
5 Recreation Act of 2015”.

6 **SEC. 2. NATIONAL RECREATIONAL PASSES FOR DISABLED**  
7 **VETERANS.**

8 Section 805(b) of the Federal Lands Recreation En-  
9 hancement Act (16 U.S.C. 6804(b)) is amended—

1 (1) by striking paragraph (2) and inserting the  
2 following:

3 “(2) DISABILITY DISCOUNT.—The Secretary  
4 shall make the National Parks and Federal Rec-  
5 reational Lands Pass available, without charge and  
6 for the lifetime of the passholder, to the following:

7 “(A) Any United States citizen or person  
8 domiciled in the United States who has been  
9 medically determined to be permanently dis-  
10 abled for purposes of section 7(20)(B)(i) of the  
11 Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (29 U.S.C.  
12 705(20)(B)(i)), if the citizen or person provides  
13 adequate proof of the disability and such citi-  
14 zenship or residency.

15 “(B) Any veteran with a service-connected  
16 disability, as defined in section 101 of title 38,  
17 United States Code.”; and

18 (2) by adding at the end the following:

19 “(3) ADJUSTMENT OF ENTRANCE FEES.—The  
20 Secretary shall adjust entrance fees applicable to in-  
21 dividuals that are not holders of a pass made avail-  
22 able under paragraph (2)(B) in a manner so as to  
23 maintain total receipts.”.
