6	(a) In General.—Section 1847A(c)(3) of the Social
7	Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395w-3a(c)(3)) is amended—
8	(1) in the first sentence, by inserting "(other
9	than customary prompt pay discounts extended to
10	wholesalers)" after "prompt pay discounts"; and
11	(2) in the second sentence, by inserting "(other
12	than customary prompt pay discounts extended to
13	wholesalers)" after "other price concessions".
14	(b) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
15	this section shall apply to drugs and biologicals that are
16	furnished on or after January 1, 2010.
